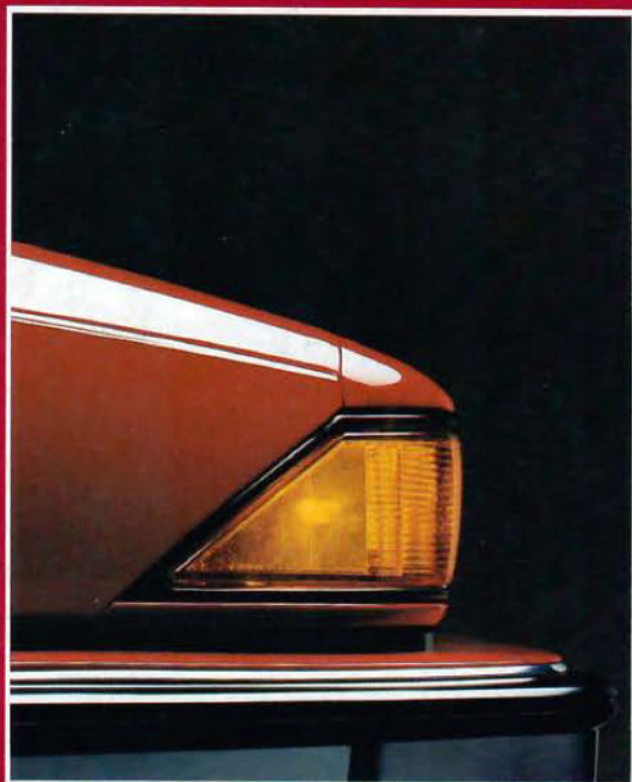

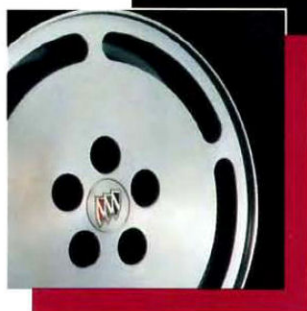

Under the classic look is substance: The V-6 technology Buick pioneered has led to the smooth 3.1-litre V-6 that's standard on Regal and the available 3800 tuned-port injection V-6.

The solid feel of command and control is enhanced by 4-wheel disc brakes and 4-wheel independent DynaRide suspension or the Gran Touring suspension that's standard on the Gran Sport Coupe, available on other Regals.

REGAL GRAN SPORT COUPE

One look tells you this one is all business. From the air dam and fog lamps in front to the big, 16-inch wheels and Eagle GT blackwall tires all around, to the reclining bucket seats and special trim inside, the Regal Gran Sport Coupe makes an unmistakable statement. It backs it up with the 3.1 litre 140 hp multi-port fuel injection V6 controlled by the sporting Gran Touring suspension and driving a 4-speed automatic transmission.

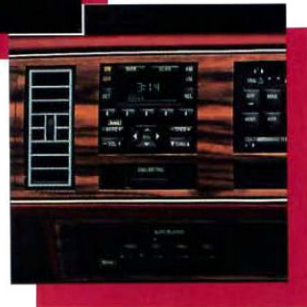

INTERIORS THAT ARE REGAL INDEED

The watchwords here are comfort and style. The elegance begins with rich fabric upholstery and deep cut-pile carpeting (plush Thaxton carpeting in the Limited Coupe and Sedan) that are every bit as comfortable and luxurious as they look.

Technology with a purpose enhances driving convenience. A digital speedometer and analog fuel gauge are standard and those controls which are not electronic have low-travel push buttons.

Air conditioning, AM-FM stereo radio with seek and scan and clock, and tilt steering wheel are standard.

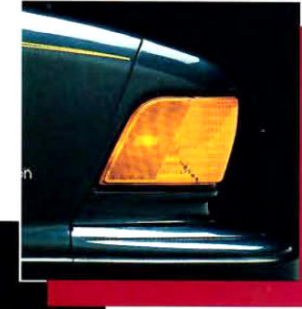

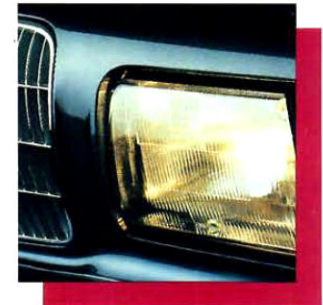

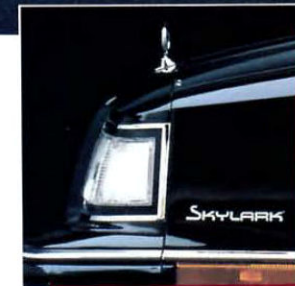

THE SKYLARK COUPES

A look all their own gives the Skylark Coupes a distinctly different personality. Youthful in looks, exuberant in style and nimble in handling, the Skylark Coupes are every inch a Buick.

The appointments in the Skylark Custom Coupe include power rack-and-pinion steering, rich carpeting and upholstery and the 2000 Series ETR® AM-FM stereo with seek and scan, dual extended range speakers and clock.

The Skylark Gran Sport is something else again, carrying on a Buick tradition of providing serious performance and the looks to go with it.

It's a coupe that's all business, from the front air dam to the aero rocker panels to the beefy Eagle GT + 4 blackwall tires on 14-inch aluminum wheels. for bulky objects plus access to the trunk from inside.

We are continuing to pursue new technologies and new products to enhance our environmental commitment. You can help, too. Always use unleaded gasolines or the recommended oxygenated fuels as described in the owner's manual. Have your vehicle serviced regularly to ensure that it is in top running order. Maintain your tires at the recommended pressure. If each one of us takes these small steps, the overall result will be a cleaner Canada.

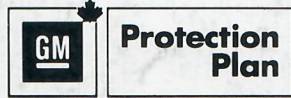
