In the rear, more luggage room than many cars that are bigger overall.

You can put an amazing 22.6 cubic feet of luggage into this Rabbit. But there's still room for expansion. Fold down the rear seatback and the capacity becomes 38.9 cubic feet, measured up to its roof line.

For easy loading, the door opening is nearly as wide as the car itself. Two pneumatic springs make the hatchback door easy to open or close with one hand.

In all, about 87% of this Special Value Rabbit is devoted to passenger and luggage room. This efficient space design brings the car's overall length in at just 12 feet, 11.3 inches. The perfect size for slipping into parking spaces other cars have to pass by.
