The quality of comfort in the Jetta GL is quickly apparent. The plush velour of the fully reclining bucket seats is particularly inviting. Yet because this is a driver's car, the engineers have not forgotten the lateral support so necessary during spirited touring.

And to help you get into the spirit of performance, a sport steering wheel is standard. So is full instrumentation—tachometer and digital clock, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge and voltmeter—with the standard 1.7 liter fuel-injected engine.

Air conditioning can be added to the flow-through ventilation system. And if more fresh air is desired, an optional sunroof can be selected.
