

Dasher's unique combination of performance, handling and economy is no accident. It's the result of some very purposeful and carefully thought-out engineering.

Step on it, and Dasher's powerful 1.6 liter overhead cam engine with fuel injection propels you from 0 to 50 mph in just 8.1 seconds.

The road hugging quality you feel as you put Dasher through its paces is the result of the traction gained by placing the engine over the drive wheels. This front wheel drive system literally pulls you around sharp corners with awesome stability.

Beneath you is Dasher's silken smooth suspension — independently sprung in front with McPherson struts, and the unique VW torsion crank axle in back. And all the while, you're in total control with Dasher's rack and pinion steering system that transmits forces quickly and evenly, giving you fantastic feel of the road.

To assure you of smooth, precise stops, Dasher is equipped with power-assisted disc/drum brakes. And this year, the brake booster has been enlarged to make stopping even easier than before. For added safety, dual diagonal braking circuits are used to provide a back-up in case one of the cirucits should fail.


Steel belted radial tires on the Dasher add their own contribution to precise handling. And their low roll resistance helps us achieve Dasher's enviable record for gas economy, based on 1978 EPA estimated mileage with manual transmission. As a further aid to good engine efficiency and performance, Dasher is equipped with a continuous fuel injection system that precisely meters fuel to the engine, as determined by such conditions as temperature and engine air intake.




