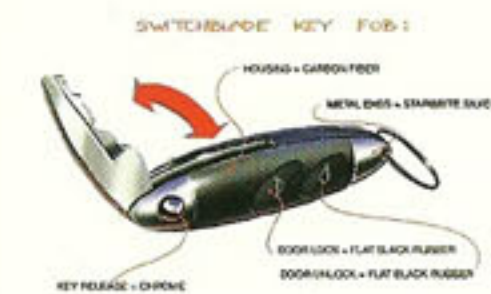
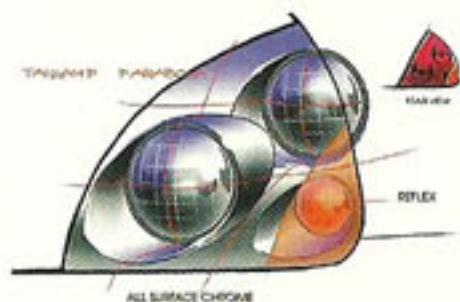
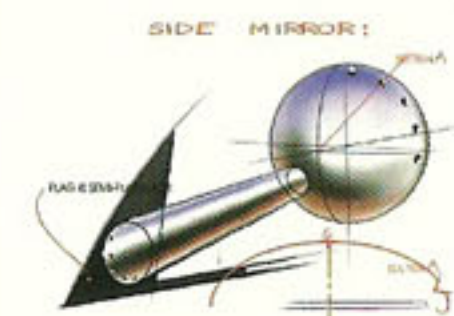
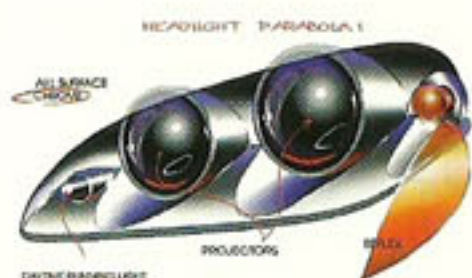
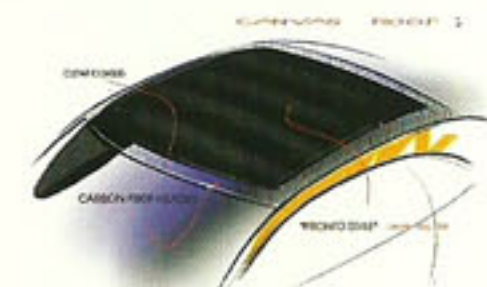
For over ten years, Chrysler concept cars have been attracting plaudits at Motor Shows worldwide. And often the very same concepts end up on the road. The Viper and the Prowler are two examples of how Chrysler's insights into design actually influence production. So, please welcome the 3-door Pronto Cruizer coupe, Chrysler's "American approach for Europe." The Pronto Cruizer has Art Deco design features such as wings and running boards, as well as a roll-back fabric top.

Inside, the Pronto Cruizer has an aluminum finish armrest, centerstack, door handles, steering wheel, stick shift knob and instrument panel (with pale blue dials), as well as leather and carbon trim. Its innovative 1.6 liter engine produces 115bhp at 5600 rpm and is mated to a 5-speed manual gearbox. Other features include an Alpine navigation system. Today, it's in your dreams. Who knows, tomorrow it could be in your garage.
