Golden Milestones of GM's first fifty yearsa parade of scientific, engineering and styling firsts





1908—Precision machining makes parts interchangeable, paves way for volume production, solves service problem.

1910—Closed body protects passengers in bad weather, makes possible year around driving.

1912—Electric self-starter eliminates crank, permits women to operate cars.

1914—Compact V-8 engine creates new standards of performance and smoothness.

1923—Fast drying lacquer eliminates month-long painting operation, sets new standard of beauty and durability.

1926—Shatter resistant safety glass protects passengers.

1928—Synchro-mesh transmission simplifies gear shifting.

1933—Independent front wheel suspension stabilizes ride and steering.

1933—No-Draft Ventilation, by controlling circulation of fresh air, increases passenger comfort and safety.

1935—*Turret Top* roof, stamped from single steel sheet, improves appearance, durability and safety.

During its first fifty years General Motors has built thousands of improvements into its cars. Many of these originated with GM's three central creative staffs—Research, Engineering and Styling. Listed here are 20 Golden Milestones of automotive progress pioneered by General Motors.

1939—Automatic shift transmission (*Hydra-Matic*) eliminates clutch pedal and simplifies driving.

1948—High compression engine sets new standards of economy and performance.

1948—Torque converter automatic transmission (*Dynaflow*) provides uninterrupted transmission of power.

1949—Two-door hardtop body sets new trend in automotive styling, improves visibility.

1952-Autronic Eye provides automatic headlight deflection.

1953—Molded glass fibre plastic replaces sheet metal body in new Corvette.

1954—Panoramic windshield gives greater visibility, sets an industry-wide style.

1955—Four-door hardtop body combines sedan convenience with hardtop style.

1957—Fuel injection system gives greater driving response and performance.

1958—Air suspension eliminates conventional springs, gives uniform improved ride regardless of load.
