But in Dodge Unibody construction, body and frame are one integral unit, held tightly together by thousands of separate welds, protected against rust and corrosion by no less than 6 distinct chemical and finishing treatments. Generous use of sound-deadening materials throughout Dodge Dart further enhances its structural quietness and your comfort.

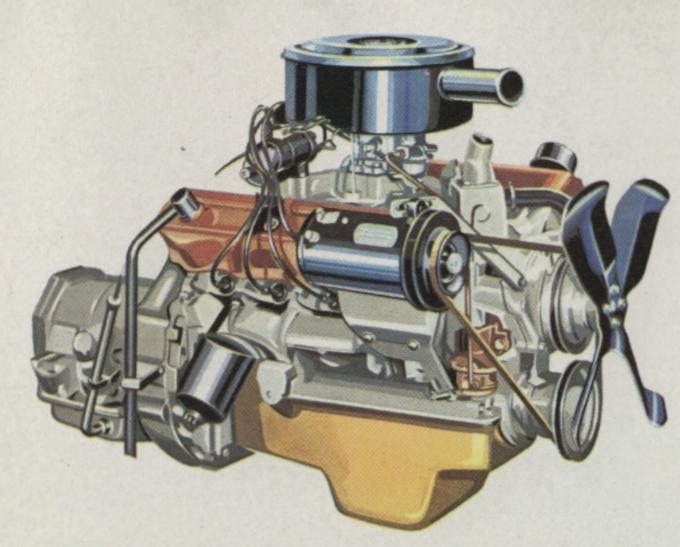
Another example is the famous Dodge

Torsion-AIRE ride,improved even further for 1961. Solid chrome-steel torsion-bars in the front suspension twist when the wheel hits a bump, absorbing the shock more efficiently than any coil-spring ever made. They all but eliminate sway on curves and nose-diving during quick stops, giving you a combination of smooth ride and rugged roadability still unmatched by other competitive cars.

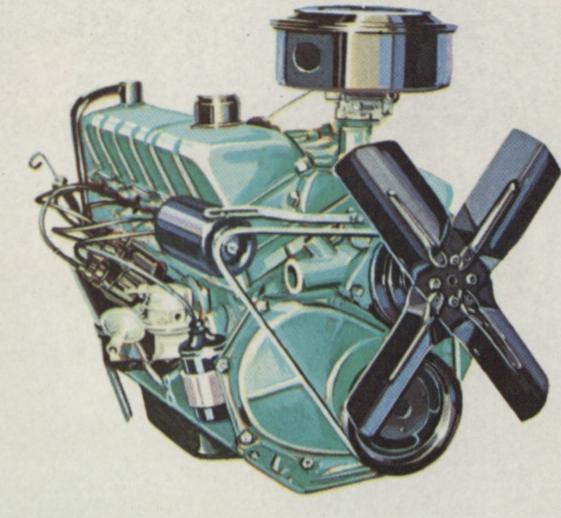
Still another example is the variety of engines offered by Dodge. You may choose either the Economy Slant Six or powerful Dodge V-8's, all designed to operate at full efficiency on regular gasoline (you may study the specifications of these engines on the last page). You'll notice another example of fine Dodge engineering every time you bring your Dodge Dart to a stop. Dodge total-contact centreplane brakes offer 184 square inches of total brake-lining area, (Suburban, 202 square inches) with two brake cylinders on each front wheel for added efficiency.

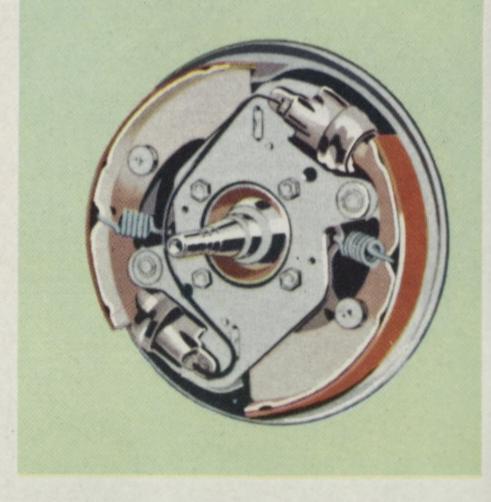

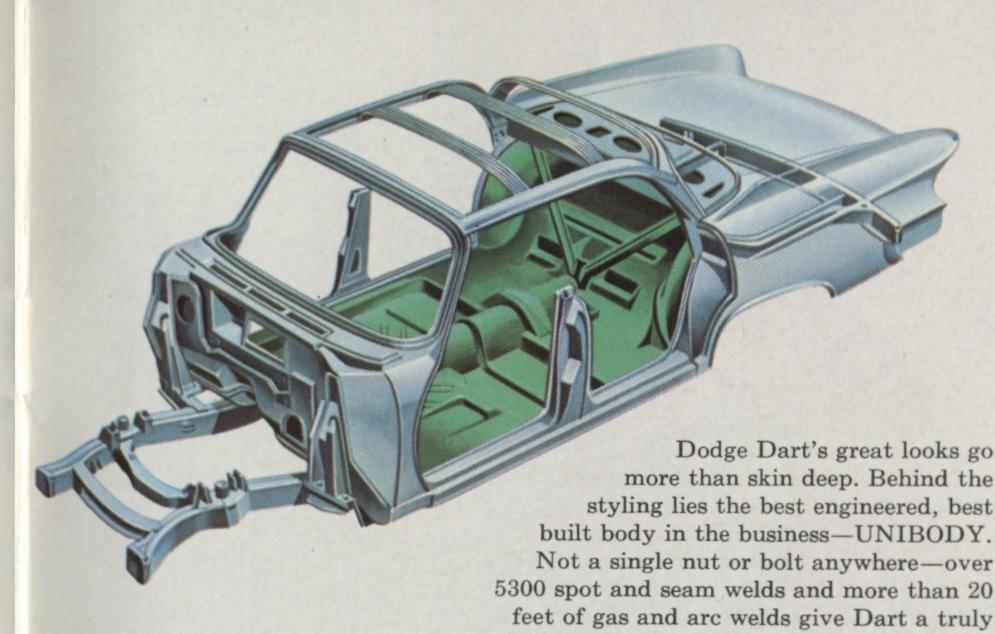
Dodge Dart's powerful V-8, 313 cubic inch engine is a top-performer. Here's hustle . . . with economy. A two-stage step up jet in the carburetor gives smoother part-throttle performance and finer mixture control thoughout the entire engine speed and load range. Also available is the powerful new Dodge 361 cu. in. V-8. Both V-8's are built to go best on regular gas.

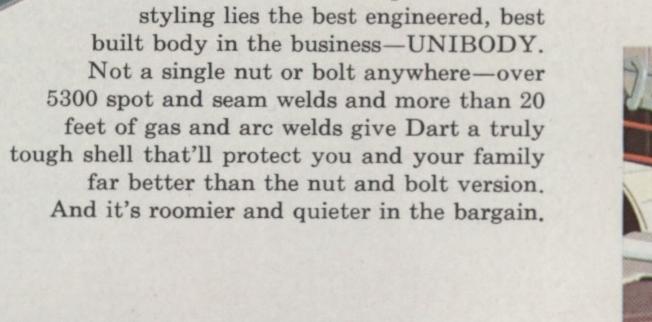


Gas-nursing Economy Slant Six sits at a 30 degree tilt. Intake manifolds are virtually equal in length, giving equal feeding to all six cylinders. Result? Snappy performance with real economy. Improvements for '61 include a new anti-percolation feature in carburetor to give quicker hot starts, and a new choke, heat valve and carburetor calibration to improve low-speed performance and economy.



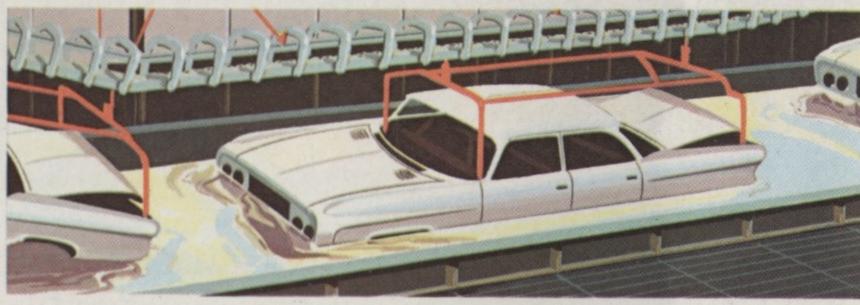
Hydraulic Total-Contact brakes give you stopping power to spare throughout Dodge Dart's entire speed range. Tough Cyclebond linings minimize brake fade-out on sustained braking. And Dodge Total Contact brakes use *two* cylinders on each front wheel for added efficiency.

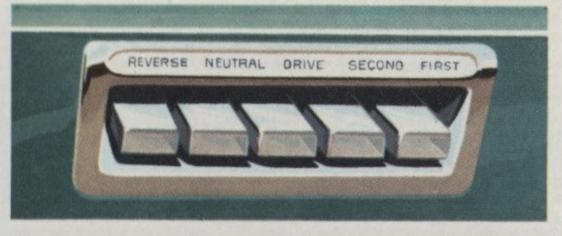
Each Unibody goes through a 6-stage rust and corrosion proofing process. Then after two coats of primer have been applied, each Dart is given two thick coats of tough enamel to give it a deep sheen that'll look like new for years.



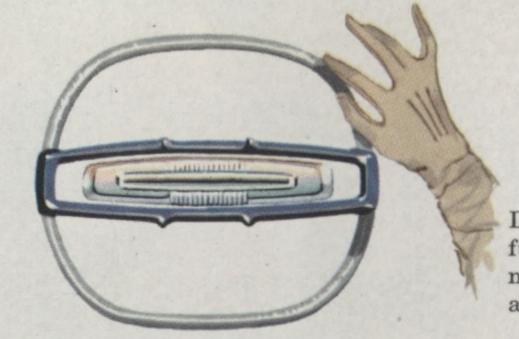
Nerve centre of the Dodge Dart puts everything where the driver can use it best. A horizontal speedometer is flanked by nacelles housing oil, ammeter gauge and turn signal lights. New push-button consoles for automatic transmissions and heater have pearl white buttons clearly identified by word callouts on separate light bars. Temperature and fuel indicators are in a concave recess between the push-button consoles.



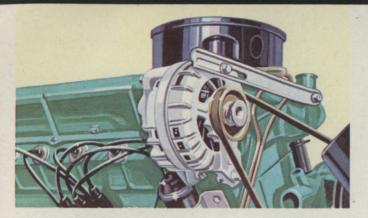
Total-Contact power brakes are firm and positive. Stop with tip-toe action.
