

In fact, the Montero is so smooth, stylish and user friendly it's easy to overlook its tough, rugged, athletic four-wheel drive capability.

AN INVITATION TO EXPLORE

Just because Montero is tough doesn't mean you have to be. Inside the spacious Montero cabin, the eye can see well ahead, over traffic and down the road, through tinted glass and big wide side mirrors.

The clean, readable dash is uncluttered and to-the-point, yet includes full instrumentation. Speedometer, tachometer, fuel and temperature gauges are fully visible, while the radio and dual bi-level heat/ventilation system are within easy reach.

For all-season comfort, an integrated air conditioning system is available as are power windows. The Sport model includes a Mitsubishibuilt, high-fidelity four-speaker AM/FM stereo/cassette system, variable intermittent wipers, tilt steering

column, quartz clock, a functional console tray, voltmeter, oil pressure gauges and an innovative inclinometer. Inside the Montero Sport cabin,

Inside the Montero Sport cabin, the theme is one of functionality, not gimmickry. An inviting, luxurious cloth upholstery covers the spacious interior. The rear bench seat folds forward to provide the useful cargo space of a much larger vehicle. And the driver's seat has it's own suspension system, allowing the driver to adjust to his weight or road conditions. The passenger seat folds forward to allow easy access to the back.

A swing-away rear door can be locked and unlocked from the instrument panel, and a remote fuel lid release is standard.



As part of the functional design, a high pressure spray washer helps keep the halogen headlights clean, and a rear window wiper/washer helps keep the aft view clear.





CITY SMARTAND COUNTRY WISE

Montero was designed to crawl across rock, power through mud, and blast down dusty trails with ease.

Its strength comes from a sophisticated 2.6 liter four cylinder engine that delivers 109 horsepower and makes cruising through the backwoods just as easy as cruising downtown.

Hefty all-terrain radials mounted on 15-inch wheels contribute to exceptional ride, handling, and traction. Vented, power assist front disc/ rear drum brakes provide balanced braking control. Built to take on the toughest terrain, the Montero features full skidplate armor at the gas tank, engine, and transmission/transfer case.

Its front differential is mounted directly to the frame, providing an extra measure of impact protection and a full 9.1 inches of ground clearance, with 8.3 inches minimum running ground clearance at the rear differential.

A 5-speed manual overdrive transmission is standard, but an optional 4-speed automatic overdrive transmission is available which adds a welcome luxury to Montero's city ways.







Among Montero Sport's ingenious features is a shock absorbing suspension type driver's seat. The seat is suspended on springs, with a shock absorber in the system to soften and dampen the motion of rough terrain.



The tension is adjustable for the driver's weight or the seat can be locked in place. It's ingenious and practical, providing a soft easy ride in normal conditions and firm support on demand.

A BACK THAT BENDS Montero's versatility was never more apparent than in the comfortable cabin. The front seats fully recline, for a nap when you are far from civilization. The headrests adjust for comfort depending on the position of the seat back and the height of the passenger.

Extra conveniences, like a center console with a covered storage compartment, height adjustable steering column and a front passenger assist grip, abound inside the Montero's cabin.

THE MEASURE OF MOTION

Mounted high in the middle of the dash on the Montero Sport model and Monteros with the SP package is a gauge that dramatizes Montero's go anywhere spirit. It's an inclinometer that measures the vehicle's angles of slope both foreand-aft and side-to-side.



And to do it smoothly and quietly, patented Dual Engine Stabilizers,™ consisting of counter-rotating shafts within the block, dampen engine vibrations. They are so effective that Porsche licensed them from Mitsubishi Motors for all its 944 series engines.

Automatic valve lash adjusters on the intake and exhaust valves, help reduce engine noise and maintenance.

An electronic fuel feed-back carburetor carefully measures engine functions to insure fast starts and smooth

performance.

BRAKES TO MATCH THE

POWER Power assisted, 10inch vented front disc brakes and self adjusting rear drums provide a total brake swept area of 321 square inches, for balanced stopping power.




